Dr. Hamman is a Professor in the Department of Renewable Resources, at the University of Alberta. He is an internationally-recognized climate scientist with expertise in global change biology, spatial data analysis, genetics, and climate change adaptation. He teaches statistical analysis, and advises on experimental design and data analysis. He received his Ph.D. from the University of British Columbia, and a Master's Degree from Syracuse University. He was recipient of the McCalla Professorship in 2014/2015, and was a Fullbright Fellow in 2012/2013. He recently co-lead a Genome Canada Large Scale Applied Research Project on climate change adaptation in forestry, which integrated social science research with genetics, genomics, and climate sciences.
