

Dr. Richard Vyn Biography

Dr. Vyn is an Associate Professor in the Department of Food, Agricultural & Resource Economics at the University of Guelph, Ridgetown Campus. He grew up on a cash-crop farm near Guelph. He completed a Ph.D. in agricultural economics at the University of Guelph. Richard's research focuses primarily on economic analyses of agricultural production practices, such as cover crops and pesticide application, and on farmland values in Ontario. His other areas of research include marketing of agricultural and food products and economic impacts of agriculture and rural policy. Richard has published in a variety of journals, including *American Journal of Agricultural Economics*, *Land Economics*, *Ecological Economics*, *Canadian Journal of Agricultural Economics*, and *Journal of Agricultural and Resource Economics*. Richard is a board member for the Canadian Agricultural Economics Society and the webmaster for the Northeastern Agricultural and Resource Economics Association.
