Peter Kevan (Ph. D. 1970) is University Professor Emeritus, School of Environmental Sciences, University of Guelph. He is also Adjunct Professor and Research Associate at St. Louis University, the Missouri Botanic Garden, the Royal Botanic Garden, Hamilton, ON, and the University of Ottawa. He was Scientific Director, Canadian Pollination Initiative Strategic Network (NSERC-CANPOLIN) from 2009 – 2015 with 49 scientists and their teams in 29 institutions across Canada. He is an ecologist with broad interests in terrestrial ecosystems from the Arctic to the tropics as well as in agriculture and forestry. His extensive publication record includes over 300 scientific papers, book chapters, encyclopaedia entries, and popular articles. He is one of the pioneers of bee vectoring research in Ontario and globally.
